- 4. No crossbred poultry allowed.
- 5. Birds entered in a filthy condition may be rejected at the discretion of the Stewards of Judge.
- 6. Birds are to be free of external parasites.
- 7. All care will be taken with the exhibits, but neither the Alpha Show Society nor its appointed Stewards will accept any responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits while at the show or in transit to and from the grounds.
- 8. The Alpha Show Society reserves the right to transfer entries to the correct class where wrongly entered.
- 9. During the Show, all exhibits will be in the custody of the Stewards and shall not be touched or handled by the owner or any person other than the Judge or Stewards under any pretence whatsoever, without the consent of the Steward in Charge.
