



By participating in the Event:

- I acknowledge that it is a condition of participating in the Event that I do so at my own risk. I accept all risks and release the Show Society from all claims, demands and proceedings arising out of or connected with my participation in the Event and indemnify them against all liability for any injury, loss or damage arising out of or connected with my participation in the Event. This release continues forever and binds all of my heirs, successors, executors, personal representatives and assigns.
- I acknowledge that it is a condition of participating in the Event that the Show Society and any person or body directly or indirectly associated with the Event are absolved from all liability arising for injury or damage to myself or my property howsoever caused arising out of my participation in the Event whatsoever whether due to any negligent act, breach of duty, default and/or omission on the part of the Show Society and any person or body directly or indirectly associated with the Event, or otherwise.
- I acknowledge that participating in the Event may involve a risk of serious injury or even death. I accept all risks necessarily flowing from participating in the Event.

Nomination Fee \$2 unless otherwise stated.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Copy of **Healthy Horse Declaration & Indemnity Forms** must be handed to the Show Secretary on arrival. **Stall and Electric Fence fees** must be paid before competing.
- 2. Stall bookings must be prepaid. \$15 per stall. For bookings contact Mrs A Bettridge on 07 4985 3400 or complete online form www.tinyurl.com/alphashowhs18
- 3. Electric fences can be erected on the western side of the paddock fence off the camping area. The fee of \$20 for electric fences must be paid to the Secretary prior to the start of the show.
- 4. HELMETS must be worn at all times whilst riding, including costume classes. Alpha Show Society adheres to the QCAS Horse Regulations Rules & Requirements in regards to helmet policy at our show. All junior competitors are reminded of the mandatory ruling requiring the compulsory wearing of a helmet. Currently QCAS recommends the following helmet standards: Horse Safety Australia VG1, ATSM International ATSM F1163 & SAI Global AS/NZS 3838 or PAS015 helmets in all phases. These rules are currently being reviewed and changes will be made in line with QCAS recommendations when they are advised.
- 5. Competitors must be correctly attired in all classes.
- 6. Ponies may be led by an adult or child, but **not** ridden by an adult.
- 7. No stallions shall compete in Hack events or riding events unless otherwise stated.
- 8. Stallions must be lead by person 17 years and over.
- 9. Children's age will be taken as the 1st day the show. Birth Certificate must be available for inspection on request by stewards. No exceptions.
- 10. Lady or Gentleman rider means rider must be 17 years old by the first day of the show.
- 11. Children under the age of 14 years of age CANNOT compete in Ring 1.
- 12. A junior rider 14 years and over competing in Ring 1 can compete in Ring 2 where stated on a Galloway or Hack. Neither Ring will be held up for any competitor competing in both rings.
- 13. Mounts ridden in Ring 1 by a Senior Riders, 17 years and over, may not be ridden in Ring 2 by a Junior Rider under 17 years. Mounts ridden in Ring 2 by a Junior Rider may not be ridden by a Senior Rider in Ring 1.
- 14. A novice horse is one that has never won a championship ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the close of nominations.
- 15. A maiden horse is one that has never won a blue ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the close of nominations.
- 16. A novice rider is one that has never won a championship ribbon at any Agricultural Show at the close of nominations.
- 17. Classes for local hack events are confined to Competitors who have resided in the Alpha/Jericho District for the previous 6 months minimum.
- 18. Competitors nominated in 2 rings where times clash must make a choice of which event they are to compete in, and, with the exception of championships, events will not be held up for late riders under any circumstances.
- 19. Lodgement of a completed horse health form will be taken as a guarantee that the animals specified therein are free from all disease as far as is known by the owner and/or exhibitor. In the case of an infectious disease being spread through or by an exhibit, the exhibitor shall be held responsible.
- 20. The Alpha Show Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold Alpha Show Society Inc. blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.
- 21. Alpha Show Society Inc., will not, under any circumstances, hold itself liable for any accident on the ground.

Departure

Horses moving across the Tick line of Alpha need to adhere to the Department of Agricultural and Fisheries guidelines on moving low risk tick carriers within Queensland. These procedures are available in the Queensland Biosecurity Manual on the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries website (www.daf.gld.gov.au)

Conditions

- 22. Protests **must** be lodged in writing to the Secretary within one (1) hour after the awarding dispute has been made. A protest fee of \$50 is required & will be retained by the Society if in the opinion of the executive the protest is frivolous.
- 23. Stock, where practicable, shall be paraded as directed by the Ring Master. Exhibitor's who do not comply, may be fined & disqualified at the discretion of the ring master, whose decision will be final. All prizes won by said exhibitor shall be retained by society.
- 24. The age of all horses are to be calculated as from 1st August. Every horse foaled before 1st August in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date.
- 25. Any animal which, in the opinion of the Stewards is not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected by them, & debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is entered.
- 26. All horses entered for competition in stud classes must be registered in a stud book of their respective breed society recognised by the Royal National Association. Registration papers (or copies) must be produced upon request where breed regulations require, nominations must be accompanied by breeding details.
- 27. The committee reserves the right to add classes as deemed necessary to cater for unexpected interest in particular breed classes.

Measuring

- 28. Measuring of horses, galloways & ponies will commence Monday afternoon. Official EFAQ Measuring Card/ Show Horse Committee Queensland Cards will be accepted. An allowance of 3/8" is made for shoes. Measuring Cards issued at the Alpha Show will be the only ones recognised at this & all shows on the Central Highlands circuit. Entry into either ring may be denied without a height card.
- 29. Ponies not to exceed 14 hh. (Except Registered Australian Saddle Ponies & Registered Riding Ponies who are not to exceed 14.2 hh). Galloways over 14 hh not exceeding 15 hh.

Judging

- 30. If there are sufficient numbers for competition, at the Judges discretion horses may be split into separate classes.
- 31. No person except those engaged in charge of the exhibit shall be permitted to remain in the yards or ring during judging.
- 32. Stock appearing in the ring for judging will be disqualified if same are decorated with medals, ribbons, or prize tickets awarded at previous shows or events.
- 33. Geldings unless otherwise required by the various breed societies, are not eligible for Champion Male, but will have their own Championship at the end of the breeds exhibits for which they are eligible.
- 34. Champion Led Mare/Filly of each section breed/society in Ring 1 will compete for Grand Champion Led Female. Champion Led Stallion/Colt of each breed/section in Ring 1 will compete for Grand Champion Led Stallion/Colt.
- 35. Where there is more than one Breed Grand Champion for each exhibit, points will not be accumulated for Aggregate Trophy. Otherwise points for Aggregate trophies are calculated as follows:
 - ◆ 9 points Supreme Champion: ◆ 7 points Champion: ◆ 5 points Reserve Champion:
 - ◆ 3 points First; ◆ 2 points Second; ◆ 1 point Third
 - In the event of a tie for any place, the points awarded for the place & the next lower place shall be equally divided.
- 36. The Judge may at their discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is in the opinion, not of sufficient merit.

District Hack Conditions

37. Residential conditions for district hack events are that competitors in the district hack classes in Ring 1 (Class 38 & Class 49) & Ring 2 (Class 100), must be resident within the boundaries of the old Jericho Shire for at least the previous six (6) months.

Grand Parade

- 38. Any exhibitor who fails to parade their exhibit in the Grand Parade, may at the discretion of the Chief Steward forfeit all prize money/trophies won.
- 39. Supreme Champion trophies will be presented during the Grand Parade on Wednesday. Winners for these prizes must be present at Grand Parade.






